This initial tranche of funding is set at **£6.7m**, which is the amount needed to satisfy the legal requirements of the Agriculture (Retained EU Law and Data) (Scotland) Act 2020 (i.e. to enable the continued operation of current CAP schemes and policies” from 1 January 2021, which includes a requirement for at least 5% of the Pillar 2 budget to be allocated to LEADER (aka CLLD).
