The Scottish Government committed £11.6 million of funding for financial year 2023-24 to support CLLD across rural and island Scotland, which included a first tranche of statutory funding (£6.7m) ringfenced for resource use by the CLLD [Local Action Group \(LAG\)](#) network.

A top up of £2.9m capital for use by LAGs was allocated, bringing the total amount of funding directed to the LAGs to £9.6m.

Of the remaining funding, £900,000 was approved to support collaboration activities between LAGs and foster better partnership working.

The remaining £1.1m was later realigned to meet the emerging Scottish Government priority of “path to balance”.

\*Due to lack of funding coordination function within Kelvin Valley & Falkirk (KVF) LAG area, the allocation for KVF was redistributed amongst the remaining LAGs allocations.
